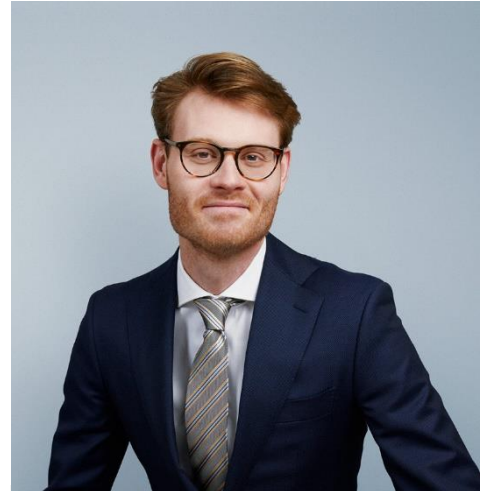
About Roland Bertens
