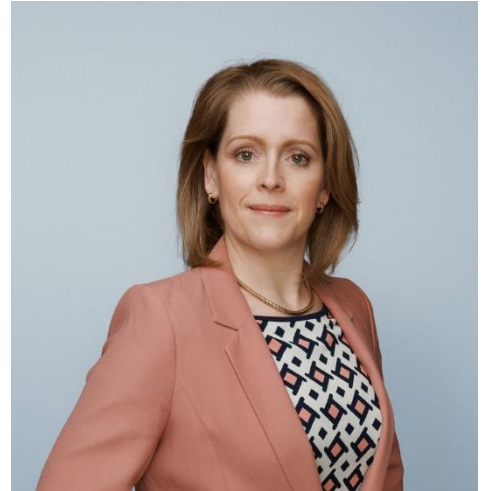
About Stephanie van Eck-Vernooij
